Peninsula Humane Society Hosting Kitten Nursery Shower and Cat Adoption Event

Unique opportunity for public to view tiny kittens in nursery care

May 11, 2016 (Burlingame) – On Saturday, May 21, 12 to 3:00 pm, the Peninsula Humane Society & SPCA (PHS/SPCA) is hosting a “baby” shower for newborn kittens receiving care inside its Center for Compassion’s second-floor Kitten Nursery. The location is 1450 Rollins Road, Burlingame.

During this free, public event, guests can watch volunteers syringe-feed tiny kittens, ask staff about our life-saving work and learn about volunteer and foster care opportunities. We will also have face-painting and coloring activities for children and sweet treats for all guests.

In addition, foster parents will be visiting PHS/SPCA with their foster kittens during the shower event. Guests will be able to interact with these kittens – which are slightly older and more robust than the fragile nursery kittens -- and watch them play.

Guests are strongly encouraged to bring shower gifts for the kittens; the most needed items include KMR formula (liquid only), baby wipes, paper towels and cotton balls. Guests can purchase a few of these gift items in our on-site store, located on the first floor along with our limited edition “Clowder of Cats” T-shirt designed by a local graphic designer. Sales of all items benefit PHS/SPCA shelter animals.

While the nursery kittens are still too young and not yet available for adoption, PHS/SPCA has waived adoption fees for all cats age seven or older and all bonded pairs of cats. This adoption promotion is beginning Friday, May 20 and extending through Sunday, May 22.
